What is Carers SA?

Carers SA is the Carer Gateway (Australian Government Initiative) provider in South Australia, and provides these Carer Gateway Services:

Connect with other Carers

Meet with people in similar caring situations and share your stories, knowledge and experience.

- In-person meet local Carers, share adviceand learn from each other in a safe space.
- Workshops Workshops are available on different topics aimed at connecting, supporting and empowering Carers.

Coaching

Coaching can be up to 6 x 1 hr sessions and discussions can be around anything the Carerwants to focus on including:

- Health and wellbeing.
- Understanding inclusion and advocacy.
- Exploring the emotions of caring.
- Exploring how the caring role can changeover time.
- Navigating the day to day challenges of thecaring role.
- Exploring how to build and maintain mutuallysupportive relationships.
- Work, study and volunteering.
- Exploring the financial implications of thecaring role.

Financial support

Get financial support to assist you in yourCaring role.

Financial support packages:

- one-off practical support in the form of equipment or an item to assist you in yourcaring role.
- a range of ongoing practical supports, such as planned respite or transport, provided over a twelvemonth period.

myagedcare 居家养老服务



年满 65 岁,持有 Medicare 卡的老人可以 在 My Aged Care 申请居家养老,以提高老 人在家独立生活能力,同时也为子女照顾 老人产生的不安和压力而提供支援。

澳洲居家养老的福利政策主要分为两种. CHSP 和 HCP。政府评估人员会到您家里 来进行面对面评估。

【CHSP联邦家居支援服务】

请致电福利会 8212 2988 我们将为您提供全程指导

■CHSP 是一个比较基本的养老项目。如果老人身体还很健康,只需要很少量 的帮助, 比如请人帮忙做家务, 交通接送, 参加社交活动, 那么可能评估人 员会评估你为 CHSP 项目。您将会收到一个推荐码,然后您需要找到一家符 |合资格的机构来为您提供这些服务。服务机构会根据您需要的服务类型,服 **,**务的频率,您家所在的区域来决定可不可以接收。费用是按每次服务收费 I的、您用的所有服务、都是十几刀每小时、大部分费用都被政府承担了。

【HCP家居配套服务】

HCP 分为四个级别,根据老人所需的护理需求复杂性依次增高。每年政府资 助从一万刀到六万刀不等,包括一系列的居家服务内容,比如个人护理/洗 「澡、上门清洁、社交活动、出行购物、交通接送、餐食、一对一陪伴、理疗 师、职业治疗师等。以及参加我们定期举办的出游,聚餐等社交活动。

【HCP费用】

HCP 费用每个人都不一样。它基于您的个人收入,包括您的养老金。领取澳 洲全额养老金的人以及年收入不超过 33,735.00 都可以免费获得 HCP。 『对于没有养老金的老人,在选择服务机构之前,需要找 Centrelink 进行收入评 『 估,会要求您提供您所有的收入来源,其中包括海外收入(国内养老金)。

一旦获批,您可以选定福利会作为您的服务机构,我们是由澳洲政府认证 符合资格的养老服务提供机构,同时也是一个非盈利机构。我们的工作人 员会说英语, 普通话和粤语, 可以满足不同文化背景老人的需求。

什么是 Carers SA?

Carers SA是南澳的一个澳大利亚政府的 项目 "Carer Gateway" 的服务提供机 构,为照顾者提供以下服务:

与其他照顾者连接

myagedcare Home Care Services



Seniors who are 65 years of age or older and hold a Medicare card can apply for My Aged Care Services to enhance their ability to live independently at home and to support their children with the anxiety and stress that comes with caring for the elderly.

There are two programs under My Aged Care: CHSP and HCP. A government assessor will come to your home for a face-to-face assessment.

To guide you through the process, Call CWS on 0882122988

【Commonwealth Home Support Program (CHSP) 】

CHSP is an entry-level support services. If an elderly person is still in good health and needs some basic help, such as domestic assistance, transportation, and social activities, the assessor will probably assess you for the CHSP program. You will then receive a referral code and you will need to find a Service Provider at My Aged Care to provide these services for you. The Service Provider will determine if they can accept you based on the type of services you need, the frequency of services, and the area of your home.

【Home Care Packages (HCP)】

There are four levels of HCP, in increasing order of complexity of care needs required by seniors. The annual government funding ranges from \$10,271 to \$59,593 and includes a range of in-home services such as personal care, in-home cleaning, social activities, shopping trips, transportation, meals, one-on-one companionship, physio therapists, occupational therapists, and more. As well as participation in our regular outings, gatherings and other social events.

【HCP Fee】

HCP costs are different for everyone. It is based on your personal income, including your Age Pension. The HCP is free for people who receive the full Australian Age Pension and for those who do not earn more than \$33,735.00 a year.

For seniors who do not have a pension, you will need to see Centrelink for an income test before choosing a provider, and you will be asked to provide all of your sources of income, which will include income from overseas.

Once approved, you can choose CWS as your service provider. We are accredited by the Australian Government as a qualified aged care provider and a non-profit organization.

Our staff speak English, Mandarin and Cantonese to meet the needs of seniors from different cultural backgrounds.

弗林德斯大学 - 澳大利亚失智症照顾者培训和 支持项目 - ISUPPORT

iSupport 是一项针对失智症患者照顾人员的自学 失智症技能培训计划。该计划使照顾者能够获得失 智症患者及其照护者的信息和照护服务。

有关 iSupport 计划的全球研究表明,该计划可以 提高照顾者的自我效能感,增强他们的心理健康, 减轻他们的压力。这些对照顾者的影响将使他们能 够在家中保持高质量的失智症照护,减少医院和急 诊室的使用,并推迟失智症患者入住老年护理机构 的时间。

iSupport 计划包括六个模块: 痴呆症简介;作为 照顾者; 照顾我自己; 提供日常护理和应对行为变 化;我参与消费者指导的护理。

▶ 根据照顾者的需求,我们制作了以下 iSupport 多 媒体资源,供**失智**症照**顾**者和为照**顾**者提供支持的 专业人员(如护工)使用。

FLINDERS UNIVERSITY - ISUPPORT FOR DE-**MENTIA PROGRAM**

The iSupport program is a self-learning dementia skill training program for carers of people with dementia. The program enables carers to access information and care services for people with dementia and their carers.

Global research on iSupport program indicates that the program can improve caregivers' self-efficacy, enhance their mental health, and reduce their stress. These outcomes on carers will enable them to maintain high-quality dementia care at home, reduce hospital and emergency department use, and delaying the admission of individuals with dementia into aged care facilities.

The iSupport program includes six modules: Introduction to Dementia; Being a Caregiver; Caring for Myself; Providing Daily Care and Coping with Behavioural Changes; and My engagement in consumer-directed care.

Based on carers' needs, we have created the following iSupport multimedia resources for dementia carers and professionals who support carers (such as support workers) to use.

- Older adults are more susceptible to dehydration, so drinking enough fluids is crucial.
- Good nutrition is essential for energy, immune support, and overall health, especially in hot weather.
- Protecting skin from sun exposure is important all year but especially in summer.
- Heating can cause exhaustion quickly in older adults, so keeping cool is vital.
- Some medications increase sensitivity to sunlight or impact hydration.

As we step into the warmer months, it's important to focus on health practices that help older adults stay comfortable, safe, and healthy. Summer can be enjoyable, but the heat brings unique challenges, especially for those in aged care.

"Remember: if you experience signs of overheating or dehydration, seek help"

Older adults should drink around 8 cups of water daily, eat hydrating foods and avoid sugary and caffeinated drinks.

Apply SPF 30+ sunscreen, wear protective clothing, and limit outdoor time during peak sun hours.

Use fans or air conditioning to stay cool, wear breathable clothing, and take cool showers to avoid overheating.
